Lewis County General Hospital welcomes all patients with disabilities. Interpreter services are available for persons who are hard-of-hearing, visually impaired or who speak limited or no English. These services are free and available 24 hours a day.

In maintaining compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, we will provide auxiliary aids and services to patients with disabilities, including sign language interpreter services for patients with hearing disabilities, to ensure effective communication.

Lewis County General Hospital also has available a telephonic interpreter service to accommodate the needs of limited English patients.
